Discussion Items

- 1. (Ave) CHSC grant is beginning Year 3 of 5 on July 1. Sarah Flack (Dir) & Mo Tidball (CCE) are working together to schedule CCE's "Blender Bike" in the schools. Kids will pedal to make smoothies!
- 2. (Ave) Willard Task Force: Highest and Best Use Study funded by the IDA and the County is in process. Jeff Shipley from the Chamber is coordinating publicity and has suggested a website & social media presence for outreach to the community. its development. Immigrants likely to be housed at SUNY/CUNY sites but not likely at Willard.
- 3. (Ave) NYS Parks is buying Camp Babcock-Hovey in Ovid on Seneca Lake. SC Bd of Supervisors will confirm at mtg tomorrow: Seneca County will manage it.
- 4. (Karel) Sustainability
 - Four of Lodi's Climate Smart Communities/Clean Energy Task Force are trained Climate Stewards; mapping damaged areas from 2018 flooding. Community Solar is hooking up with Ampion's solar array in Marathon. EV charging stations on the horizon.
 - The Composting Task Force meets monthly, developing a public survey. At all 3 June Festivals, composting will be highlighted in the 3 community gardens. Ryan Staychock will operate CCE's Zero Waste pop-up tent at Lodi Fest and it will be available for others to staff at Olde Home Days and the Strawberry Festival. Frank Sinicropi (SCHD) is developing a county-wide waste plan.

- The lack of zoning has made our area vulnerable to exploitation, and increased the plethora of Air B&Bs, which has in turn reduced the availability of rentals. Good land use planning is possible without zoning.
- A community garden is starting up in Seneca Falls.
- (Tony) Interlaken "Park for All Ages" Development plans continue for this 1acre site. Besides recreation, a retention pond is being considered to prepare for the flooding of Lively Run Creek. Budget TBA soon.
- (AJ) SC Health Dept is working on a Community Health Improvement Plan with special attention on mental health. Pivital's survey showed a 61% increase in food insecurity across 9 counties in NYS including Seneca.
- 5. (Theresa) STEPS Reports
